20 On December 13, 2018, the Court heard and considered the *Motion of David*
21 *A. Gill, Receiver, for Authority to Sell and Assign Claim and Judgment Against*
22 *Matthew Jennings, Or to Assign Such Claim and Judgment to the SEC or Its*
23 *Designee* (the “Motion”) filed by David A. Gill, Receiver (the “Receiver”), the
24 Honorable Andrew J. Guilford, United States District Court Judge, presiding.

5 1. The Motion is granted.

6 2. The Receiver’s proposed sale procedures, attached as Exhibit “2” to the
7 Motion, are approved.

8 3. The Receiver is authorized to assign all of his right, title and interest in
9 and related to the *Settlement and Release Agreement* attached as Exhibit “4” to the
10 Motion and the related *Judgment Against Matthew R. Jennings* (together, the
11 “Claim”) to the Securities and Exchange Commission (the “SEC”) or its designee.

12 4. The Receiver is authorized to take such further actions and execute such
13 documents as he believes to be necessary and appropriate to effectuate the
14 assignment of the Claim to the SEC or its designee.
